come the Savior of the world. As it says in Matthew, "She will bear a Son and you shall call His name Jesus, for He will save His people from their sins" (Mt. 1:21).

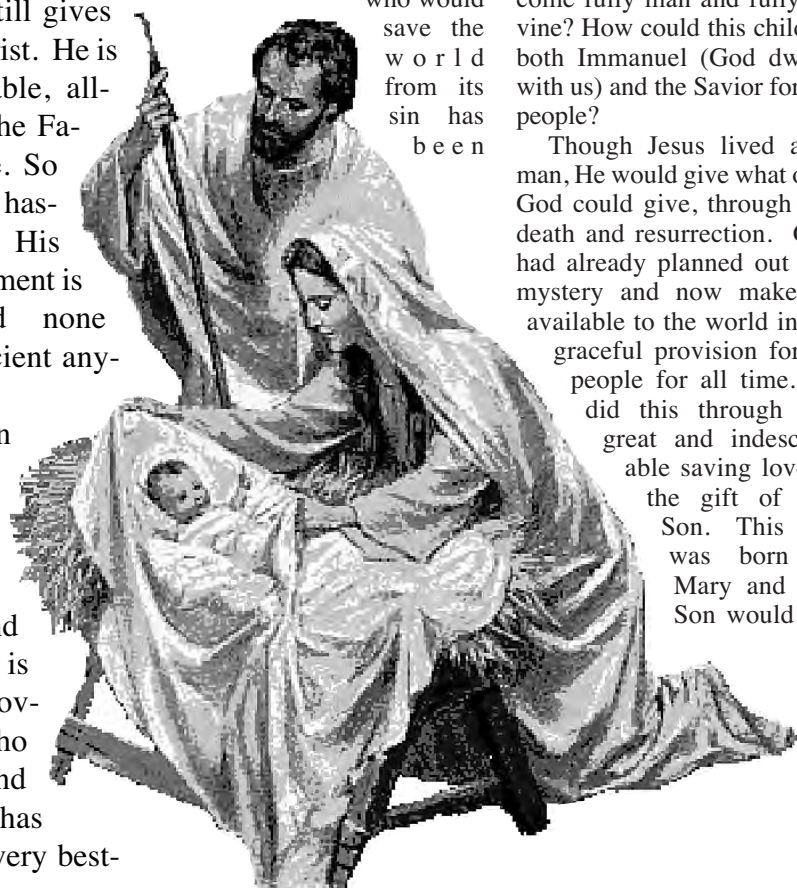
