NOTICE OF FILING FOR THE STATE GENERAL ELECTION

Notice is hereby given that a General Election will be held in Yellow Medicine County on Tuesday, November 5, 2024 for the purpose of electing candidates for the offices listed below.

The filing period for all non-presidential elector offices begins at 8:00 a.m., Tuesday, May 21, 2024 and ends at 5:00 p.m., Tuesday, June 4, 2024.

The filing period for presidential elector candidates begins at 8:00 a.m., Tuesday, May 21, 2024 and ends at 5:00 p.m., Tuesday, August 20, 2024, for non-major political party candidates and independent candidates. The certification deadline for major political party presidential elector candidates is August 27, 2024.

Candidates may file in person or by mail, if the filing is received during the filing period. Candidates who will be absent from the State during the filing period and meet the requirements of Minnesota Statutes section 204B.09, subdivision 1a, may arrange to file during the seven days immediately preceding the candidate's absence from the state.

Note: Filing offices will be closed Monday, May 27, 2024 in observance of Memorial Day.

The place of filing for federal offices is the Office of the Secretary of State, Veterans Services Building, 20 West 12th Street, St. Paul, MN 55155.

Note: For presidential elector candidates, filing offices will be closed on Wednesday, June 19 th , 2024, in observance of the Juneteenth Holiday and Thursday, July 4, 2024, in observance of Independence Day.
