The Canby School Board held its regular scheduled meeting on Monday, April 3, 2023 at 5:30 p.m. in Canby High School Room 156. Board members present: Nathan Thorpe, Brenda Full, Angela Leppke, Brittany Kockelman, Suzanne Fairchild and Tricia Bueltel. Also in attendance were Superintendent Ryan Nielsen, Elementary Principal Ryan Arndt, and the Canby News.
